1. Search Engine Overview

The document describes how to install, configure, and use software to search *The Urantia Book* in the following languages:

- English
- Russian
- Korean

This search facility is based on free software available from Copernic (www.copernic.com) called Copernic Desktop Search (CDS). An extensive **Help** facility is included within the software.

2. Installation Overview

These instructions assume that you have a copy of The Urantia Book text, in English, Russian, and/or Korean located in a folder on your hard drive and called “TheUrantiaBook”.

If you have a CD acquired from www.TheUniversalFather.org website, copy the files to the suggested folder, or other folder of your preference.

You may download a copy of any of these files at the following location:

Installation of the search feature is a straightforward process and involves:

- Download and Installation of the Search Software
- Configuration of the Search Software
- Index building (an automatic effect of the installation process)

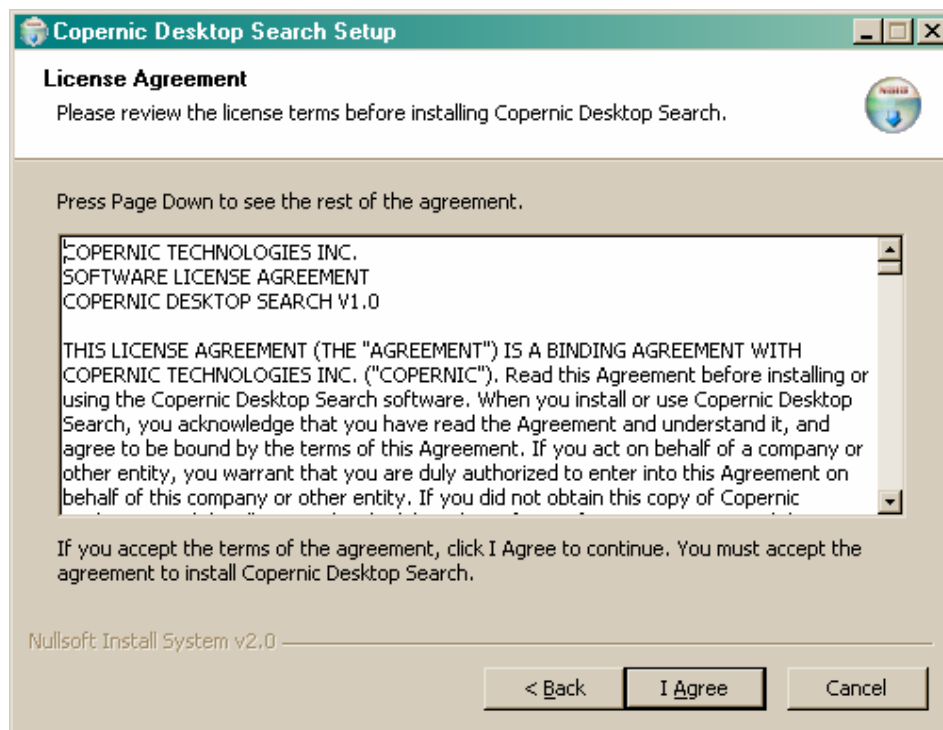
Each of these steps will be explained in detail in the sections that follow.

3. Download and Installation of the Search Software

- Proceed to the Copernic website at: www.copernic.com
- Locate the link to download the free Copernic Desktop Software (CDS)
- Download and save the software into a file where it will be permanently available (in case you need to reinstall it later)
- After double-clicking on the downloaded file, the installation process will begin and you will see the following:

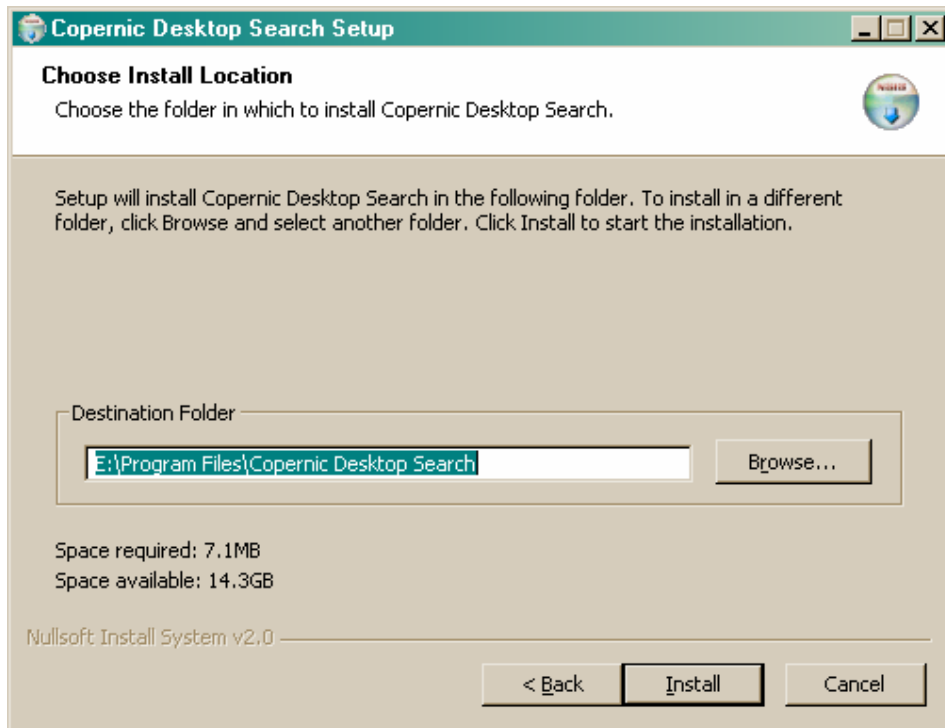


Click “Next” and then “I agree” to accept the terms of the software usage agreement.

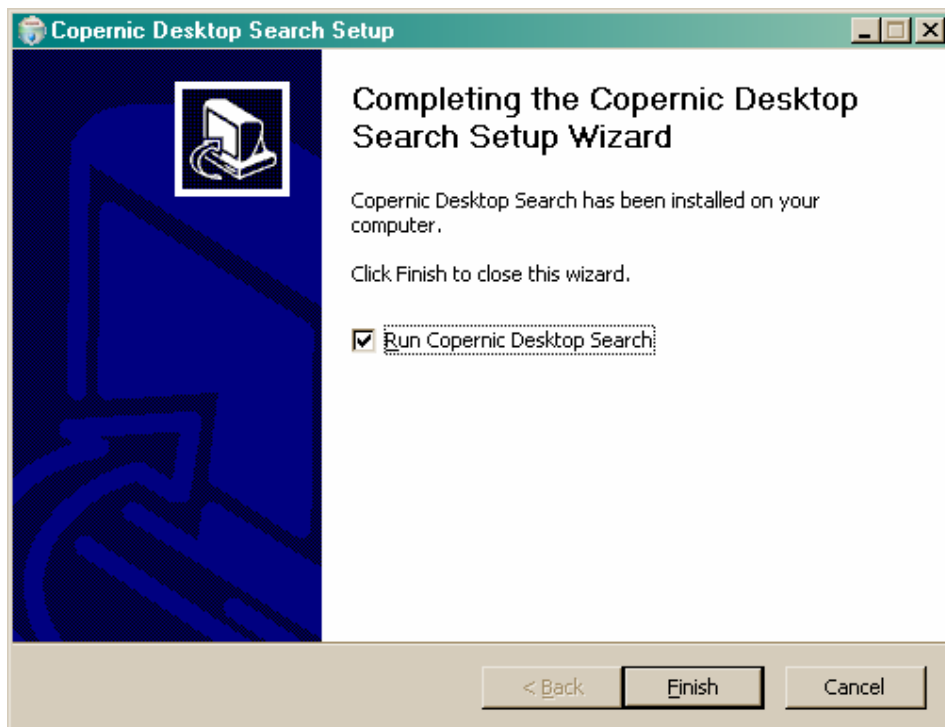


Next, you need to choose the location where the software will be installed. The default location is recommended.

Click “Install”



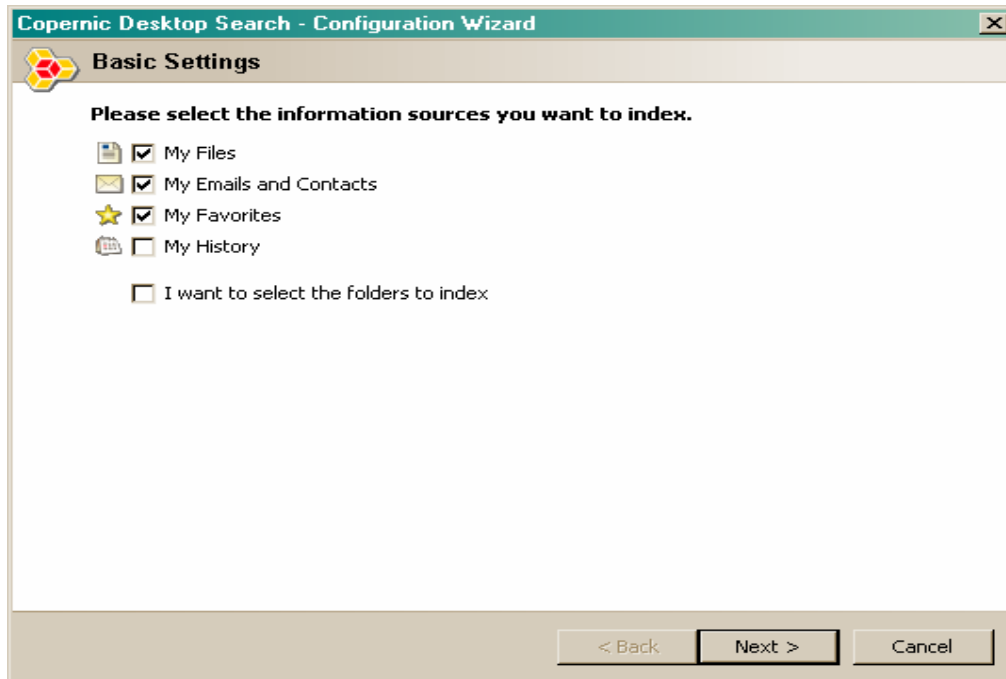
After the software has been installed, you will be asked to complete the process by clicking “**Finish**”



After clicking “Finish” the configuration process begins

4. Configure the Search Software (Configuration Wizard)

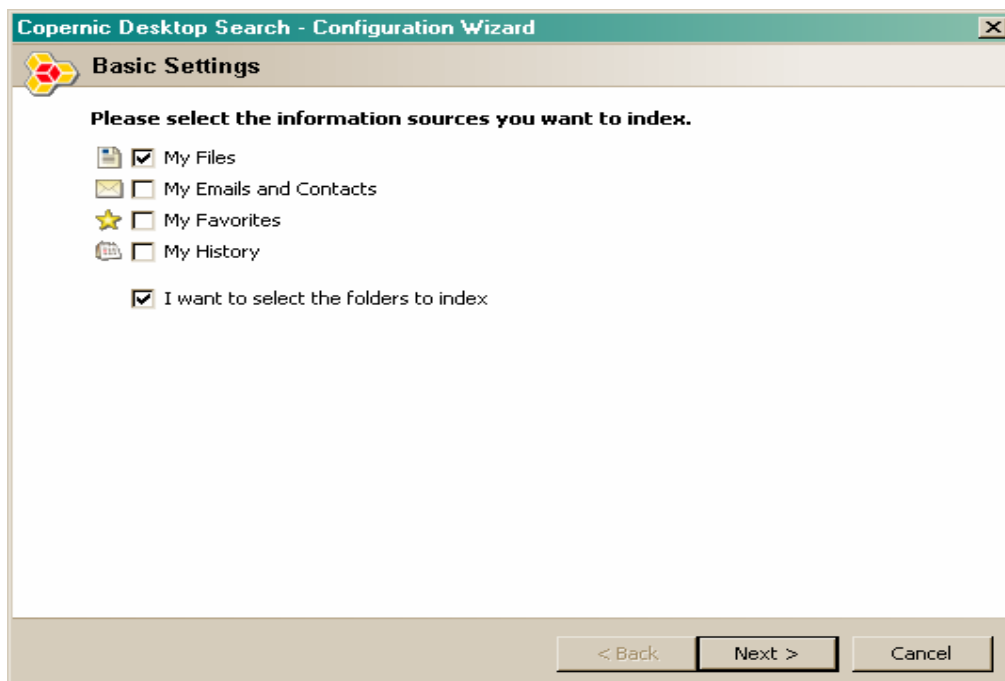
Initial Screen



Uncheck: My Emails and Contacts, and My Favorites.

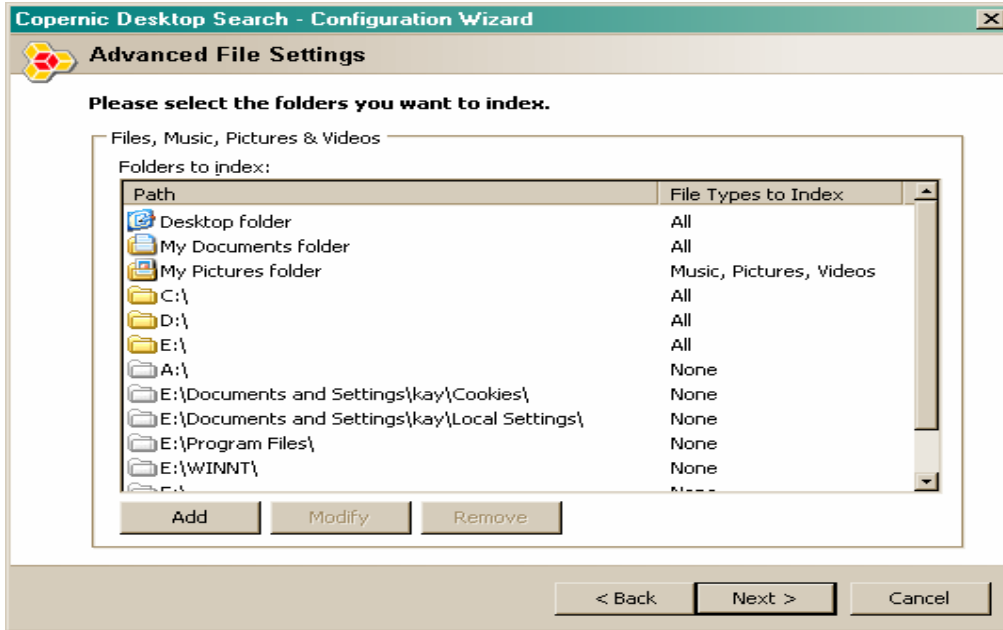
Check “I want to select the folders to index”

When finished, it should look like this

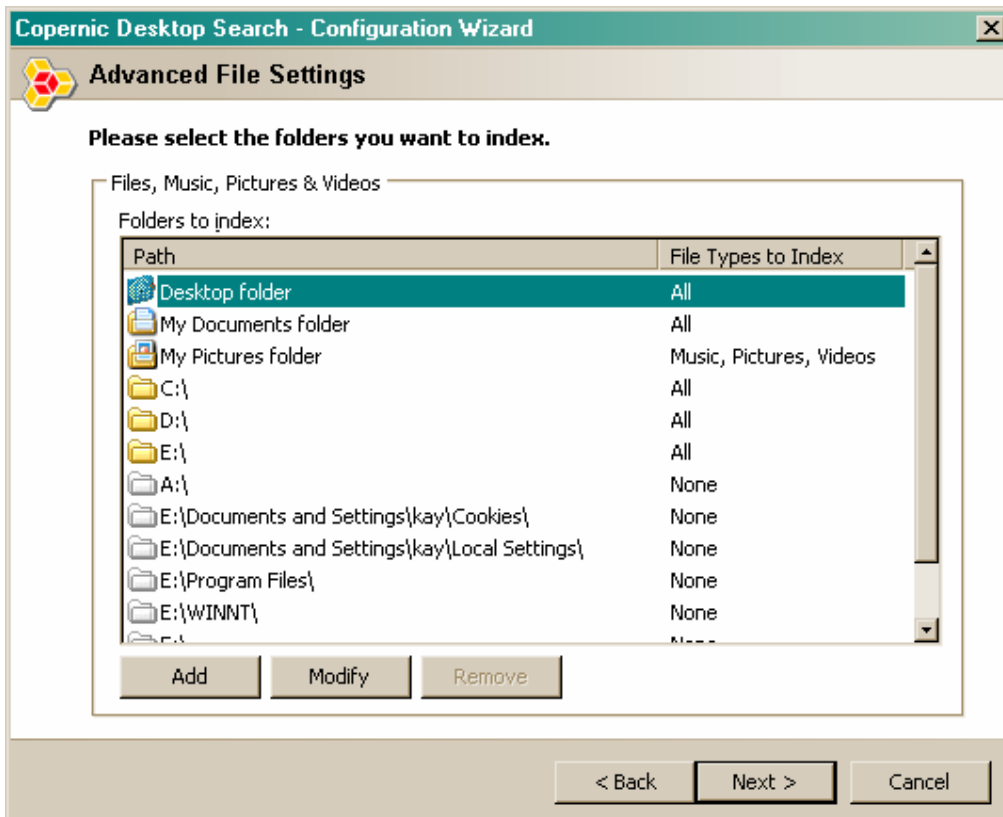


Click “Next”

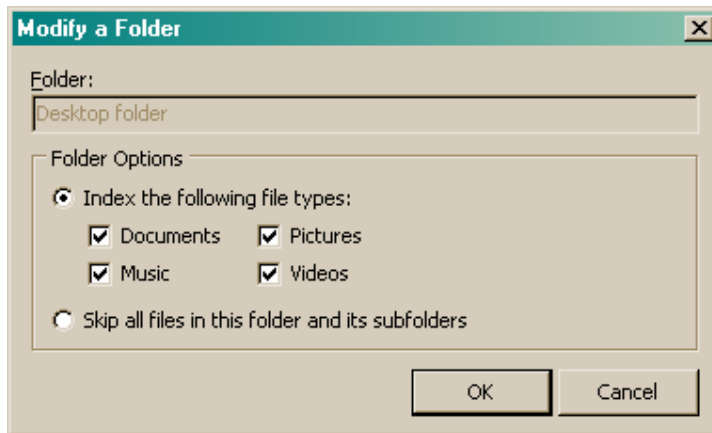
NOTE: The list of Paths shown in the Advanced File Setting window (see sample below), will vary depending on your local configuration.



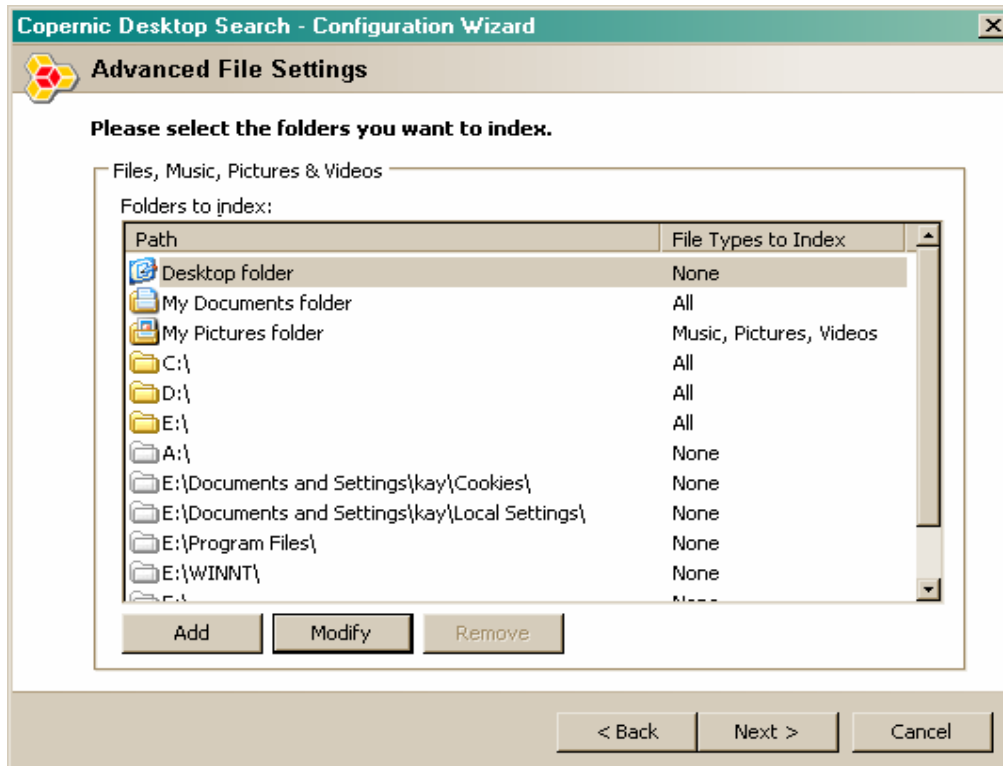
The task at this point is to MODIFY or REMOVE each entry in the list. Begin by selecting the first entry (in the case below, “Desktop Folder”).



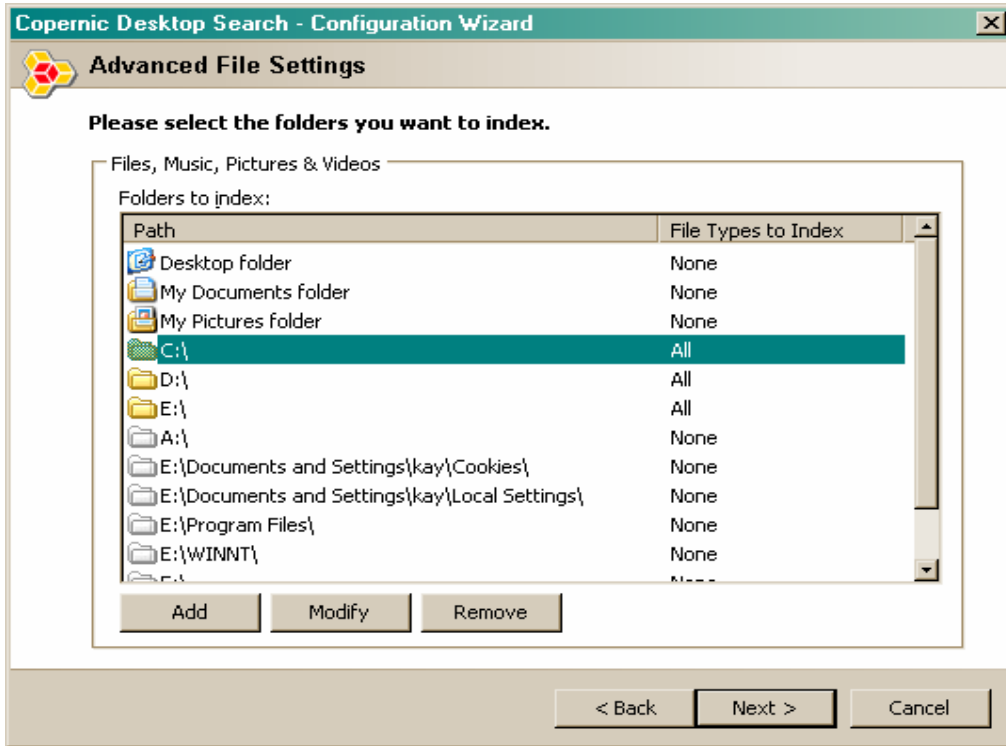
If the “**Remove**” button is greyed out (as in the case above), click the “**Modify**” button and select “Skip all files in this folder and its subfolders” and click “**OK**”



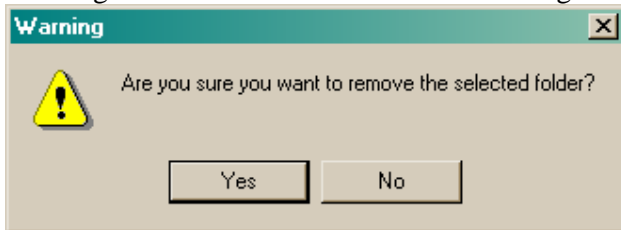
The Desktop folder should now appear in the list, as shown below:



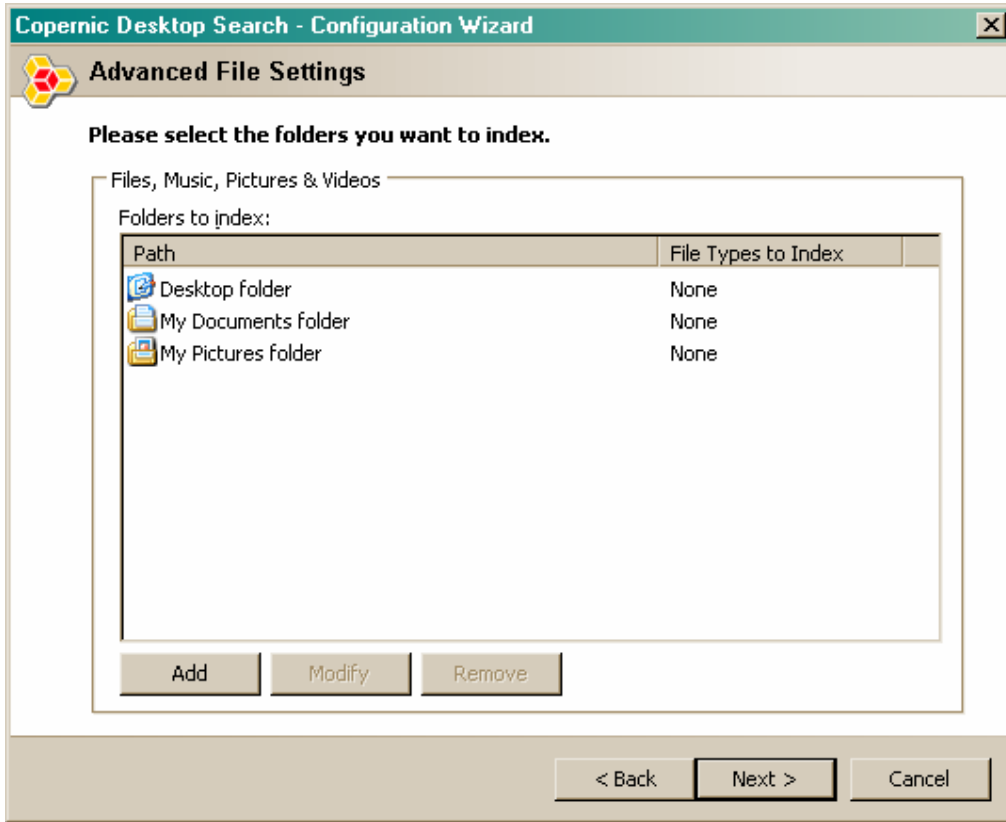
If the “**Remove**” button is available (not greyed out) as in the case below , use it to remove the entry from the list.



Clicking “Remove” will result in the following confirmation request.

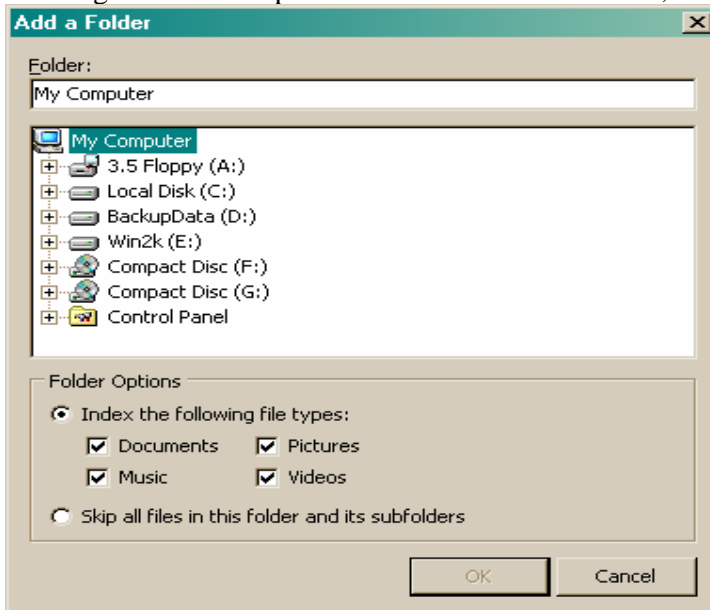


When you have finished Removing or Modifying each entry, the window should look like this:



You will now “**Add**” the folder(s) containing *The Urantia Book* that you wish to index.

Clicking “**Add**” will open the “Add a Folder” window, below.

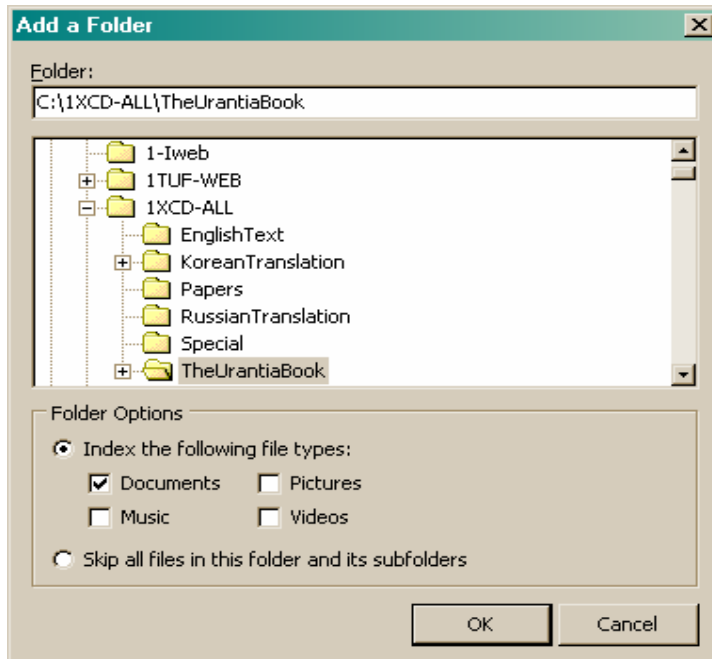


Drill down into the “My Computer” list until you locate “TheUrantiaBook” folder created earlier.

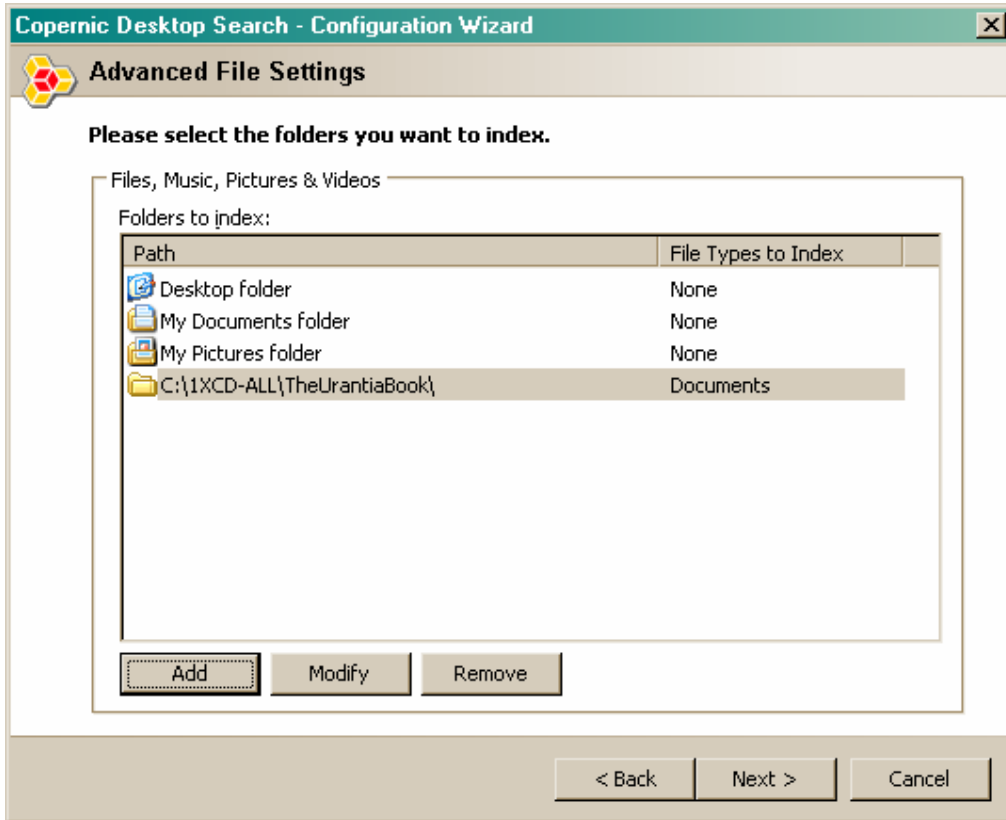
In the example below, by selecting the “TheUrantiaBook” folder, all subfolders will be indexed. This will provide a means to search the English, Russian, or Korean text.

You may, of course, drill down into “TheUrantiaBook” folder to select an individual folder (language) for indexing.

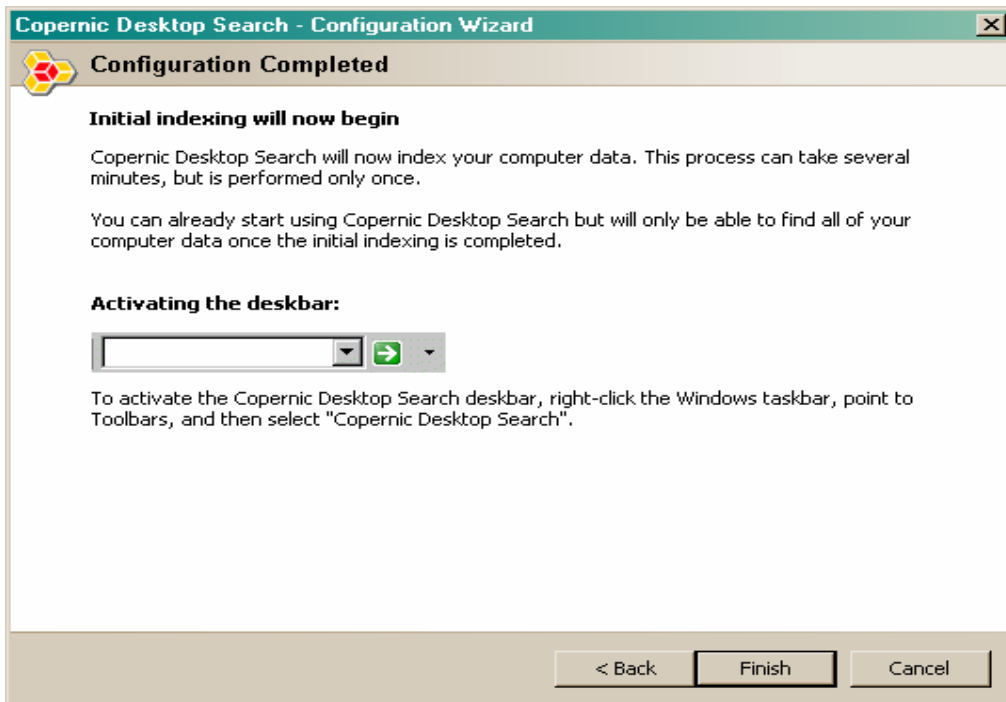
Finally, it is recommended that you deselect: Music, Pictures, and Videoa



When you are finished the Advanced File Settings list should look this this (if all languages were selected for indexing)



Click “Next” and then “Finish”



Indexing will begin and will take several minutes depending on the language(s) selected and the speed of your machine.
